Questions were solicited from those in attendance following the reading of the minutes. There was discussion of the possibility of GVSD getting on RV website under a separate tab where info can be posted so residents of GV have access.

**\*\*Forcing Members on the sewer project-**According to Brittney Molitor, Pennington Co Planning, GVSD as a government entity has the authority to force residents of GVSD to hook up to the sewer system, but if that route is taken, it must be coordinated with Brittney and Erika. This needs to be discussed thoroughly; we do not want to go down that road!!

**\*\*Revised Agreement-**We will have a revised agreement with RVSD in regards to RD language that they require in the agreement. More to come on this.

**\*\*Engineering Requirements-**We will assist with the legwork required of those who did not respond to the letters to save money. Nov 1 is the deadline date.
