MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

August 10, 2022

The monthly meeting of the Green Valley Sanitary District was called to order at 19:06 by President Jason Reitz. Present at the meeting were board members Jason Reitz, Pres., Lorretta Jangula, Sec., Marlin Kelly (via phone), and Lex Burgers in addition to a number of Green Valley residents.

A motion was made by Lex , seconded by Marlin to approve the July 14, 2021 meeting minutes. No further discussion, motion passed.

Old Business:

RC Agreement-A draft of the agreement with Rapid City was finally received this morning however, our attorney has not yet had the opportunity to look at it and respond and the board has found at least two discrepancies which have to be worked out:

- 1) the billing procedure to the residents of Green Valley will NOT be handled through the city
- 2) construction of the project will NOT be according to RC guidelines, rather to RVSD guidelines

Update on Engineering Progress-Currently at a standstill. The PER has been submitted to RD and awaiting their response. RD is aware of the RC agreement, so hopefully we should hear back within the next couple of weeks on the funding/allocation. We have also been in touch with Co-Bank and they are all on schedule, just waiting on Rural Development.

NEW BUSINESS:

New Contract with Interstate Engineering; restructured fees- The annual contract with Interstate Engineering has been revised and the fees restructured as per increase in salaries and additional costs, etc. which will be incurred on the project. The net result was an increase of \$71,000 to a new total of \$1.755 million dollars allocated to engineering costs on the project.

Review Sewer Service Agreement w/RVSD-RVSD did not receive their agreement from RC as of yet, so there is nothing to report on the agreement between RCRVSD. Also, we are at a standstill on the Special Assessment process until such time as all paperwork and agreements come together so the process can begin.

Public Comment:

Clayton Hieb suggested that the board and any interested residents set up a meeting with the RC mayor and pose questions to him as to why after two years, we are still unable to get timely responses and action on the part of the city to move this project along. The suggestion will be taken under advisement.

There being no further business, A motion to adjourn by Lex Burgers and seconded by Lorretta Jangula, no further discussion, motion passed and the meeting adjourned at 19:42
